About FSU

Florida State University, founded in 1851, is one of the nation's top public research universities and is located on Florida's oldest continuous site of higher education. Located in Tallahassee, FSU serves over 43,000 students, including 32,000+ undergraduates, from all 50 U.S. states and more than 120 countries. The university offers more than 275 undergraduate, graduate and professional degree programs including engineering, law and medicine, taught by exceptional faculty who are leaders in their fields. FSU's commitment to student success consistently results in high retention and graduation rates.

FSU's Republic of Panama (ROP) Campus was established in 1957, and it is the second oldest university in the country. For 70 years it has offered quality education and university campus experience to students from over 20 different countries. Located in the City of Knowledge, an exceptional hub of academic, research and entrepreneurial activity, FSU ROP is just a few minutes away from the Miraflores Locks of the Panama Canal. Attending FSU, Republic of Panama Campus, offers unique advantages: small classes, fully English-speaking community, a thriving campus life, academic rigor, and an affordable path towards completing a US college degree. Students can complete their General Education requirements and receive an AA (Associate of Arts) certificate before they transfer to the main campus in Tallahassee or any other institution of higher learning. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

You may be eligible for our 2+2 Scholarship!

After you complete 60 credit hours or an Associate of Arts Certificate (AA) at FSU Republic of Panama Campus, you may transition to our main campus and pay in-state tuition, **saving about \$60,000.**



To qualify, you need to:

- Be officially admitted as an FSU degree-seeking student.
- Complete 60 credit hours at FSU Panama, to include the CoreFSU courses (accelerated credits such as IB, AP, CLEP, or transfer credits are not included in the 60 hours).
- Have at least a 3.0 cumulative FSU GPA when you change campus and keep it during your studies at the main campus.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR U.S. CITIZENS

The following financial support options are available to eligible U.S. citizens and can be used towards the FSU Panama cost of attendance:

- Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA)*
- Florida Bright Futures Scholarship*
- Florida Pre-Paid (FPP)
- Veterans benefits

Dual citizens (U.S. and Panama) may also be eligible to request an IFARHU loan or apply for an IFARHU scholarship for both FSU Panama and FSU main campus tuition/fees.

Additionally, FSU Panama offers an installment plan, allowing students to pay their semester tuition in three or four portions.

**Students must be admitted as degree-seeking to qualify.*

Non-Florida U.S. citizens may qualify for “Florida Residency” for tuition purposes when transferring from the FSU Republic of Panama Campus to the main campus in Tallahassee, Florida. Eligibility requires living in the Republic of Panama and attending FSU Panama for at least 12 consecutive months, along with formal admission as a degree-seeking student prior to the transfer semester. Attendance during this time must be full-time and in-person.

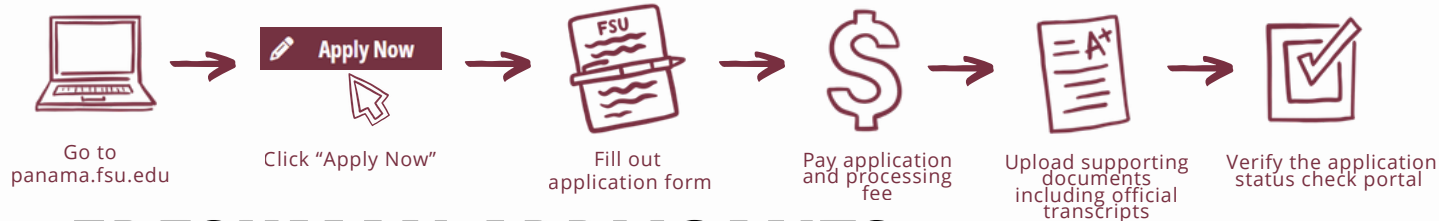

HOW TO APPLY



FRESHMAN APPLICANTS

1. Apply for Admission:

- Visit panama.fsu.edu to apply and pay the non-refundable USD \$30.00 application fee with \$70.00 processing fee.

2. Submit the Following Documents:

- Official Transcripts: Provide official transcripts from the last four years of high school. If they are not issued in English, include a certified English translation.

A foreign credential evaluation must be submitted if you attended a secondary school outside the United States, and your school curriculum did not follow the standard U.S. system. The evaluation must include: Degree equivalency and U.S. equivalent grade point average. We recommend that you select one of the evaluation agencies listed at naces.org.

- High School Diploma: Submit a copy of your diploma.

3. English Proficiency Test Scores: Official English Language Proficiency results are required of all international applicants whose native language is not English. You can self-report your official test scores and upload the official results.

- TOEFL iBT test: 80 - Test taken before January 21, 2026. (IBTOEFL).
- TOEFL iBT ® test: 4.0 - Test taken after January 21, 2026. (IBTOEFL).
- Duolingo: 125
- International English Language Testing System (Academic IELTS): 6.5
- Cambridge C1 Advanced Level or C2 Proficiency: 180
- Pearson Test of English (PTE): 55
- Michigan Language Assessment (MLA): 55

• **Test Score Submission:** For the iBT TOEFL, send your scores directly to FSU (code 5203).

• **Exemption:** Citizens of countries where English is the official language are exempt from the TOEFL or IELTS but must attach a copy of their passport to their application.

4. Official SAT or ACT Scores:

- Applicants who have taken the ACT, CLT or SAT at the time of their application must request their test scores to be sent directly to FSU (ACT is #0734) and CLT/SAT code is #5219).

- Applicants who have not taken the ACT, CLT or SAT at the time of their application may enroll at the Florida State University campus in the Republic of Panama as non-degree seeking students and progress towards degree-seeking status based on completion of academic milestones.

TRANSFER APPLICANTS

In addition to the freshman admission requirements, transfer applicants must also submit the following:

Official Transcripts:

- Submit transcripts from each college or university attended.
- If transcripts are in a language other than English, include a certified English translation.

Course-by-Course Evaluation:

- Provide an official course-by-course evaluation of all academic records from each non-U.S. college or university attended (transfer credit from non-U.S. universities will not be awarded without this evaluation).
- We recommend using any of the evaluating agencies listed at naces.org.

WORK-STUDY PROGRAM

Students who are enrolled full time and have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above, could be eligible to work part-time between 10-20 hours weekly, in different areas of the university such as the science labs, the library, the front desk, and others. Students in the program receive payment for the amount of hours worked during any given semester.

HOUSING

FSU Panama offers on-campus housing at the “**FSU Residence Hall**”, located within **walking distance to all academic facilities and** to all the service venues of the City of Knowledge which include a **food court, cafes, convenience stores, drugstore, a health clinic, and more.**

FSU offers exclusive transportation for dorm students that is available within specific class schedules. Students also enjoy free parking at both the residence hall and at our main building.
